

Acknowledgement

I _____ understand that Trinity Lutheran Preschool has set up plans, policies, and procedures to help in the prevention of COVID-19 in the following ways:

- As of January 14th, 2021, in accordance with State and Local Health Department, the state of California, and Community Care Licensing, face coverings are required to be worn by students over the age of 2 during preschool. The students will not be required to wear face coverings at snack and craft time, and for those who stay all day they are not required to wear them at lunch and rest time.
- Temperature and health screening for anyone who enters the preschool
- Face coverings for staff, students, parents/caregivers, and other children who are over the age of 2 who enter the preschool
- Face coverings for anyone over the age of 2 who are in line waiting to enter preschool or leaving the preschool
- When signing a child in the parent/guardian/caregiver is also acknowledging that the answers they have given about their child's health are truthful, that no fever or symptom reducer medication was given, and that they or someone on their pickup list will be able to pick up their child in 15 minutes if they are called and told that their child is sick and must be picked up.
- Sign in and sign out procedures are more extensive and may take more time but it is part of our prevention and procedures plan to help in protecting the children and staff from COVID-19 within the preschool.
- Classroom, bathrooms, and the playground will be cleaned and sanitized daily and high touched services will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- Toys and other shared items will be cleaned and sanitized between uses.
- Trinity Lutheran Preschool will help and educate students on practicing social distance.
- If a student or staff member has a positive case of COVID-19, their class will be canceled for two weeks for cleaning, disinfecting, and COVID-19 spread prevention.
- Trinity Lutheran Preschool will educate our students in health and safety procedures as well as COVID-19 prevention procedures.
- Trinity Lutheran Preschool cannot be held accountable for what our students and families do when they are not at preschool. What we can do is educate and facilitate the prevention measures and procedures at preschool to help in the prevention of COVID-19.
